RE: Judicial Review

Your correspondence dated 9th June 2021 has been passed to the Legal Department for consideration.

I can see from the enclosure that you are seeking permission to issue Judicial Review proceedings following your complaint to Dyfed Powys Police.

Having considered the file provided by the Professional Standards Department I can see that correspondence in this matter are historic.

Any Judicial Review Proceedings should have been commenced within 3 months from notification of the decision dated 18th February 2020.

Unfortunately, you are substantially out of time to bring a claim. Additionally your final correspondence dated 20th April 2020 provides a clear indication that you did not intend to pursue the matter any further and indeed since that time there has been no continuing act of involvement.

The Judicial Review published guidance makes it clear that as a litigant in person you are required to comply with the procedure and practice notwithstanding the fact that you are unrepresented.

Unfortunately, you have failed to comply with the protocol, the Civil Procedure Rules and have provided imprecise pleadings.

Had your claim been submitted within the appropriate timescale it would have been defended in any event.
